SAN JOSE CITY COLLEGE IS FOCUSING ON SAFETY ON CAMPUS ***After learning of an assault of a student***

(SEPTEMBER 23, 2010—SAN JOSE, CA) The San José Evergreen Community College District Police Department has issued a Safety Alert for the San José City College (SJCC) campus after reporting that a female student had been assaulted. The incident took place on the 2nd floor of the SJCC parking garage on 9/21/10 at about 3:50 p.m.

Ray Aguirre, SJECCD Police Chief, said the incident is currently under investigation and the police are asking for the community's help. The victim claims a man grabbed her sweatshirt from behind and swung her into a wall, while she was walking to her car. The suspect then grabbed her by the hips and pushed his body against hers. The victim was able to push the suspect away and ran to her car.

The description of the suspect is as follows:

Tan-skinned White Male Adult or Hispanic Male Adult
40-50 years old
Approximately 6'0" tall
180-200 pounds
Medium short hair
Had wrinkled or "weathered" cheeks
Wearing a white shirt
Had a strong smell of cologne

Dr. Douglas Treadway, interim president of San José City College, said "safety on the college campus is the number one priority and our job is to always protect the students and staff. Working with District Police, we will maintain an extra measure of vigilance to inform students and to monitor campus facilities and activities."
