Current Jag Don Medlinger commits to Cal Poly for the 2010/1011 Season

Medlinger's signing marks the 2nd straight year a SJCC pitcher signs early with Big West school

September 24th, 2009 – San Jose City College is excited to announce that Don Medlinger has verbally accepted a scholarship to play for Cal Poly SLO for the 2010/2011 season. The scholarship is one of the largest a Jaguar player has ever received.

Medlinger commits to Cal Poly after an amazing freshman campaign that saw the electric arm go 8-1 with an ERA of 2.37 and an opponents BA of .194. Medlinger was amongst the State leaders in all 3 categories and was the most sought after JC recruit in Northern California for the early signing period.
