Scholarship Descriptions, Eligibility Criteria and Application Requirements

SJCC Academic Achiever Awards – SJECCD Foundation

Scholarship amount: \$400*

***Scholarships are awarded to one Academic Achiever from each division:**

Applied Sciences Division: Air Conditioning/Refrigeration, Computer Aided Design & Drafting (CADD), Computer Tech, Construction Tech (Industrial Tech), Electronics, Laser, Machine Tech, Microwave & Telecom

Business & Services Careers Division: Accounting, Business (general), Computer Information Systems, International Business, Management/Supervision, Marketing, Office Tech Program, Real Estate, Cosmetology, Dental Assisting, Health Sciences (EMT)

Humanities/Social Science Division: Art, Dance, Drama, Foreign Language, Music, Philosophy, Photography, Speech, Multi-Media; Administration of Justice, Anthropology, Economics, Ethnic Studies, Labor Studies, Political Science, Psychology, Social Sciences

Language Arts Division: English, Journalism

Mathematics & Science Division: Anatomy, Astronomy, Biology, Botany, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Geology, Health Education, Mathematics, Meteorology, Microbiology, Natural Science, Oceanography, Physics, Physiology

Eligibility requirements:

- Must have a declared major within one of the listed divisions
- Must have completed a minimum of 12 units at SJCC as of the end of the Fall 2010 semester
- Must not be graduating in Spring 2011 or Fall 2011
- Must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 units for the Spring 2011 and Fall 2011 semester
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00
- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.50 for all SJCC major courses by the end of Fall 2010
- Must have completed a minimum of 6 units of major coursework at SJCC

Additional application materials

- Two Personal Recommendation forms from SJCC instructors (one instructor must be from the applicant's major courses)
- Typed, double-spaced essay (1-2 pages) addressing the topic, "Why I am the most qualified for this award."

Academic and Department Scholarships

SJCC Outstanding Student Award (SJECCD Foundation)

Scholarship Amount: \$800*

***NO APPLICATION REQUIRED: Recipient will be selected from those applicants qualifying for the Academic Achiever Awards with a 3.8 GPA in their major coursework**

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must have a declared major in one of the following divisions: *Applied Science, Business & Service Careers, Humanities, Language Arts, Mathematics & Sciences, and Social Sciences/Child & Family Studies*
- Must have completed a minimum of 12 units at SJCC as of Fall 2010 semester
 - Note: A.A., A.S. and Certificate students are eligible for this award, but must not be graduating in the Spring or Fall 2010 semesters
- Must be enrolled at SJCC in a minimum of 12 units for the Spring and Fall 2011 semesters
- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.00
- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.8 in major courses at SJCC by the end of Fall 2010
- Must have completed at SJCC a minimum of 6 units of major course work

Administration of Justice Scholarship

Scholarship Amount: \$400

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must major in Administration of Justice, enrolled in at least 9 units at SJCC for Spring 2011
- Must have completed at least 9 units at SJCC by end of Fall 2009 with a minimum 2.75 GPA
- Must attend SJCC during Fall 2011 semester

Additional application materials:

- Two Personal Recommendation forms: one from a SJCC faculty member and one from a SJCC Administration of Justice faculty member
- A typed, double-spaced autobiographical statement including applicant's goals in the Administration of Justice field and applicant's qualifications for this scholarship

Disabled Students Program Continuing Student Scholarship

Scholarship Amount: \$200

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a student in the SJCC DSP/S program, enrolled in at least 6 units during Spring 2011 and Fall 2011

Additional application materials:

- Two Personal Recommendation forms, one from a SJCC instructor and one from DSP staff
- A typed, double-spaced statement describing the applicant's disability
- A typed double-spaced essay of one or two pages addressing "How the Disabled Students Program has helped me achieve my goals."

Academic and Department Scholarships

Disabled Students Program Transfer Student Scholarship Scholarship Amount: \$300

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a student in the SJCC DSP/S program, enrolled in at least 9 units during Spring 2011
- Must be transferring to a 4-year institution for the Fall 2011 semester
- Must be enrolled in at least 9 units for the Spring 2011 semester

Additional application materials:

- Two Personal Recommendation forms, one from a SJCC instructor and one from DSP staff
- A typed, double-spaced statement describing the applicant's disability
- A typed double-spaced essay of one or two pages addressing "How the Disabled Students Program has helped me achieve my goals."

Graduating High School Senior Scholarship (SJECCD Foundation) Scholarship Amount: \$500 (5 awards)

Eligibility Requirements:

- \$250 each semester to be awarded students enrolling at SJCC in the Fall 2011 semester The second disbursement of \$250 is contingent upon the recipient's:
 - 1) Successful completion of a minimum of 9 units with a "C" or better for Fall 2011 *and*
 - 2) Enrollment in a minimum of 12 units for the Spring 2012 semester
- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior entering SJCC in the Fall 2011 semester

Additional application materials:

- Transcripts of completed high school courses, including Fall 2010 and Spring 2011
- Two letters of recommendation from high school teachers, counselors or administrators
- A typed, double-spaced, one-page essay addressing the topic: "How this Scholarship will Assist Me in Attaining My Educational Goals"

G. Evans Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship (SJECCD Foundation) Scholarship Amount: \$250

Eligible Requirements:

- Must be a full-time student and completed at least 12 units at SJCC by the end of Fall 2010
- Must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 units at SJCC for the Spring and Fall 2011 semesters
- Must have a minimum 3.50 GPA

Additional application materials:

- Two Personal Recommendation forms from SJCC instructors
- A typed, double-spaced essay of one or two pages in length addressing the topic, "Why I Am Qualified for This Scholarship"
