Transferring to a California State University Campus

- We have just received an official update from San Jose State University regarding Spring 2010 Admissions. Unfortunately, San Jose State University will not be accepting applicants for Spring 2010.

In accordance with CSU policy recently imposed, SJSU will not be accepting any applications for admission for Spring 2010. This applies to all categories – freshmen, transfer, credential, and graduate, in addition to earlier prohibitions against lower division transfer and post-baccalaureate. This also applies to applicants regardless of location – California resident (both local and non-local), domestic non-California resident, and international.

- We will continue to update you as we are notified of various CSU filing periods. If you are ready and plan to transfer for the Spring 2010 term, please consider other CSU campuses that are still open., especially CSU East Bay. - San Jose State University will no longer offer the Transfer Admission Agreements (TAAs) effective starting with the entering class of Fall 2010 due to the system-wide impaction. Transfer students are still encouraged to apply for admission under the regular admission process as early as possible in the filing period.

Students Transferring for the Fall 2009 term

- **Official Transcripts are due July 15th-** Unless otherwise stated by your transfer campus, official transcripts (from every college attended) are due to your transfer campus no later than July 15th to maintain your admission status. Request SJCC transcripts from SJCC's Admissions & Records Office. If you plan to have your general education coursework certified for your transfer campus, please submit the General Education or IGETC Certification request form to SJCC Admissions & Records Office as soon as possible.

Not Sure If You're Ready to Transfer?

- Meet with a counselor to verify your transfer eligibility, especially if you have not met with one yet and/or have more than 30 transferable units. We encourage you to schedule an appointment with a counselor to review your transfer status as early as possible. Filing periods for Fall 2010 admission generally begin in early Fall of 2009. Please call or visit the Counseling Office (408-288-3750).
