B. SJCC New Course Proposals (*requires Board approval*)

- (2:55p)** 1. **DANCE 013A: Dancers' Workshop - Student, Large Group - 0.5 to 1.0 Unit**
Students will be involved in the dance rehearsal process which culminates in a public performance. Students participate as dancers, rehearsing and performing newly created, original student choreography. Dancers in this course will be required to perform in a large group section of choreography using six or more dancers.
- (3:00p)** 2. **DANCE 013B: Dancers' Workshop - Student, Small Group - 0.5 to 1.0 Unit**
Students will be involved in the dance rehearsal process which culminates in a public performance. Students participate as dancers, rehearsing and performing newly created, original student choreography. Dancers in this course will be required to perform in a small group section of choreography using three to five or more dancers.
- (3:05p)** 3. **DANCE 013C: Dancers' Workshop - Student, Solo/Duet - 0.5 to 1.0 Unit**
Students will be involved in the dance rehearsal process which culminates in a public performance. Students participate as dancers, rehearsing and performing newly created, original student choreography. Dancers in this course will be required to perform in a solo or duet section of choreography.
- (3:35p)** 4. **LASER 014: Fiber Laser Technology - 4.0 Units**
Students build on knowledge of advanced laser theory to study fiber laser technology. Topics include fiber optics, CS fiber lasers, Q-switched and Modelocked fiber lasers, and MOPA's. Students will acquire skills to assemble, test, and troubleshoot fiber lasers and amplifiers.
