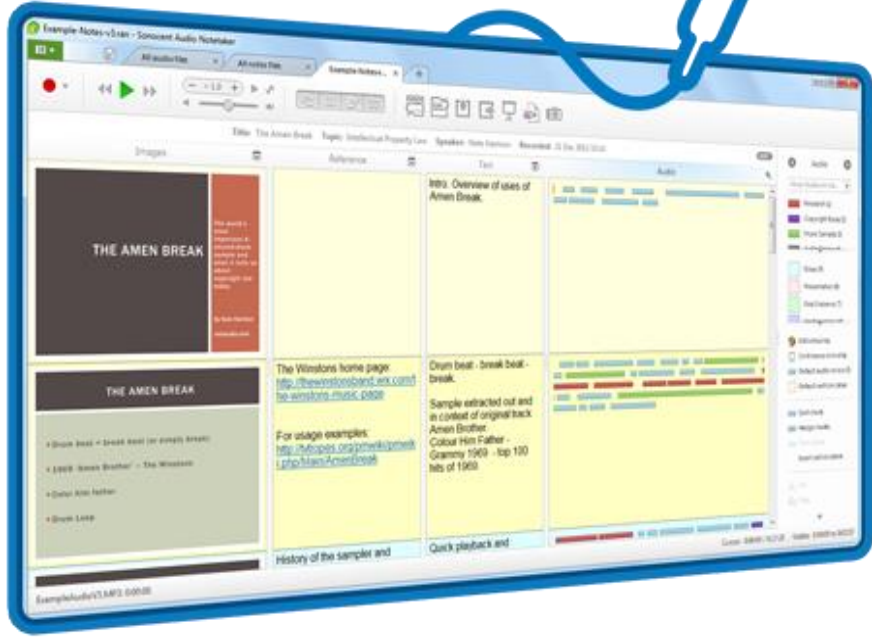

 - AB540 / Foster Youth (bus passes) – 75% funds have been used already for Spring 2016
- Outreach
 - Outreach Specialist
 - Men of Color – April 22nd
- DSPS – LD Specialist – in progress
- Health Services – increased hours Spring 2016 to 260hrs from 190hrs Fall 2015
- Extended Library Hours – increase 8 hours
- Veterans non-EOPS – book vouchers distributed Spring 2016
