San Jose City College is the first accredited college program to launch an on-line program for master's level students who are interested in pursuing their Reciprocal LAADC-R certification through CAADC. There is an increasing demand for cross-trained counselors to address both the chemical dependency and mental health needs of dual diagnosed clients. San Jose City College offers you the opportunity to develop your expertise and competency working with this challenging and interesting client base.

LAADAC Requirements through CAADAC

Official Copy of MA Degree (specific to behavioral sciences with a clinical application from a regionally accredited college or university within or colleges outside of the US.)

Proof of completion of 180 hours of alcohol/drug counseling specific education. 6 Hours must be specific to counselor ethics. (Transcripts/certificate of completion etc. Hours and topics must be listed on documentation for verification purposes.)

Supervised Practicum: 300 performance (experience) hours with a minimum of ten hours in each core function.

SJCC Requirements and Offerings

San Jose City College is offering the 180 hours of alcohol/drug specific education, and supervised practicum through its new on-line program. ***Program applicants must have transcript proof of the equivalent of Psychopharmacology, Introduction to Chemical Dependency, and Theories of Counseling as prerequisites to begin the on-line program.***

Courses and Course Pattern: LAADAC Program can be completed in 1 year.

1.5 unit courses are offered in six week rotation, 2 courses back-to-back each semester. Supervised Practicum A and B are 3 units each, offered over the course of two semesters.
